**Performance Markings and Notations:**

- Dynamic Markings:** *ff* (fortissimo) is used extensively across many parts, including oboes, saxophones, trumpets, and percussion. *fff* (fortississimo) appears in the piano and percussion parts. *sim.* (sforzando) is used in the tuba part.
- Articulation and Phrasing:** *arm. gliss.* (armature glissando) is marked for horns and trumpets. *gliss.* (glissando) is used for tubas and strings. *gliss.* is also used for violins.
- Technical Notations:** Trills and triplets are indicated with "2 3" and "3" above notes. Slurs and phrasing marks are used throughout.
- Other Markings:** *8<sup>va</sup>* (ottava) markings are present in the piano part, and *8<sup>va</sup>* is used for the timpani.
